HOW TO REGISTER

- Navigate to www.stalbertskatingcentre.ca
- Log in to your Uplifter Account. If you have not previously registered for programming at the St. Albert Skating Centre, you will be required to create an account as the parent and add your skater(s) as the participant. You will need your skater(s) Skate Canada Number
- In the category drop down menu on the right hand side of the page, choose 'Registration'
- Under 'Program Registrations', find the event you would like to enter your skater in and click 'Register'
- Choose the skater to be enrolled and click 'Add'
- View your cart and complete the 'Billing Information and Payment Information sections to complete the registration
- All events must be paid in full at the time of registration

REGISTRATION DEADLINE DATES

Register by February 6, 2024, for skaters meeting the following criteria:

- Skaters who are currently registered in St. Albert Skating Centre programming

Registration then opens on February 7, 2024, to all AB/NT/NU and Out of Province skaters, if space permits.

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES:

All entries must be received no later than **February 14, 2024, at 12:00pm (noon) MT**. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their entry is submitted by the closing date.

LATE REGISTRATION ENTRIES:

Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Chair and if space permits in the event. Entries accepted after the registration deadline date will be charged a late entry fee of \$25 per entry.

REGISTRATION CHANGE:

After the registration deadline date, changes to entries may only be made by the Competition Chair. Confirm which event to register in with your coach before submitting your registration. For any changes that are required to be made to a skater's registration, there will be a \$25 change fee applied.

WAITLIST:

Registration will close once the capacity for the event schedule has been reached and this may happen before the registration deadline date. In the event that registration is filled, skaters will be able to add their names to the waitlist. If a spot becomes available, skaters will have 24 hours to register.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:

Entry fees shall be refunded only at the discretion of the Competition Chair. There will be a \$10.00 administration fee applied to all withdrawal refunds. After the closing date of entries there will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.

MUSIC REGISTRATION

- Online music registration will require each skater to submit an mp3 file of their program to info@stalbertskatingcentre.com
- Music must be saved as the skater's first and last name and event (i.e.: John Smith, Star 2 Freeskate)
- The deadline for music submission is February 26, 2024
- Each skater will be required to carry a copy of their music on CD and have it available at rink side as backup

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

EVENT SCHEDULE:

A schedule and flight lists will be emailed to participants after the registration deadline. It is anticipated to be released after February 26, 2024.

MARKING SYSTEM:

AWARDS:

The awards ceremony for each flight will be held approximately 15 minutes after the conclusion of each event in the awards area. All skaters are asked to wear their skating attire and skates with skate guards.

SPECTATORS/PARENTS:

Spectators are permitted. In the event of any restrictions being implemented by the facility, those would be adhered to.

ACCIDENTS:

The Association and Committee of the Host Club take no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the competitions. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

PICTURES & VIDEOS:

Persons wishing to take photographs of on-ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is not permitted. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials.
