HOW TO REGISTER

- Navigate to www.stalbertskatingcentre.ca
- Log in to your Uplifter Account. If you have not previously registered for programming at the St. Albert Skating Centre, you will be required to create an account as the parent and add your skater(s) as the participant. You will need your skater(s) Skate Canada Number
- In the category drop down menu on the right hand side of the page, choose 'Registration'
- Under 'Program Registrations', find the event you would like to enter your skater in and click 'Register'
- Choose the skater to be enrolled and click 'Add'
- View your cart and complete the 'Billing Information and Payment Information sections to complete the registration
- All events must be paid in full at the time of registration

MUSIC REGISTRATION for Star 2 & 3 Freeskate Programs:

- Email music at time of registration to info@stalbertskatingcentre.com
- Must be in MP3 format and saved with Name and Category (Sarah Smith - Star 2)
- All skaters must bring back-up music on a USB flash drive

REGISTRATION DEADLINE DATES

ENTRIES: Open to all AB/NT/NU and Out of Province skaters, if space permits.

REGISTRATION OPENS: **Sunday, March, 16, 2025, at 10:00am MT**

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES: **Sunday, June 1, 2025, at 12:00pm (noon) MT**

It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their entry is submitted by the closing date.

LATE REGISTRATION ENTRIES: Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Chair and if space permits in the event. Entries accepted after the registration deadline date will be charged a late entry fee of \$25 per entry.

REGISTRATION CHANGE: After the registration deadline date, changes to entries may only be made by the Competition Chair. Confirm which event to register in with your coach before submitting your registration. For any changes that are required to be made to a skater's registration, there will be a \$25 change fee applied.

WAITLIST: Registration will close once the capacity for the event schedule has been reached. This may happen before the registration deadline date. In the event that registration is filled, skaters will be able to add their names to the waitlist. If a spot becomes available, skaters will have 24 hours to register.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: Entry fees shall be refunded only at the discretion of the Competition Chair. There will be a \$10.00 administration fee applied to all withdrawal refunds. After the closing date of entries there will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All Star categories must follow the SKATE CANADA 2024-2025 technical requirements; inclusive of the well-balanced program criteria as posted on the Skate Canada Members Info Centre at Competition Program Requirements.

EVENT SCHEDULE: A schedule and flight list will be emailed to participants after the registration deadline. It is anticipated to be released 2-3 weeks prior to the competition.

WARM-UP TIMES:

- CanSkate 5/6, Star 1 & Star 2: 3 minutes
- Star 3: 4 minutes

MARKING SYSTEM: The event is following the Skate Canada Star Event Standards for Assessment Guide.

AWARDS: The awards ceremony for each flight will be held approximately 15 minutes after conclusion of each event in the awards area. All skaters are requested to wear skates with hard guards for the awards ceremony.

PHOTOS & VIDEOS: Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden.

NOTE: You may only take photos or videos of your own skater and must be taken from the spectator seating areas, to not hamper the progress of the competition.
