ENTRY FEES: \$35 per skater, one entry per skater

HOW TO REGISTER:

St. Albert Skating Centre Skaters: will register threw their account on Uplifter Registrations.

- Go to Registration from website <u>www.stalbertskatingcentre.com</u>
- Filter by Fun Meet,
- Enter in the category Pre-Star Elements, Star 1 Elements, Adult Star 1 Elements, Star 2 Program, Star 3 Program, Star 4 Program, Adult Program, etc.
- Complete registration with payment.

Out of Club Skaters: You will register with your club, and they will provide SASC with your name and category skating in before or on the Registration Deadline. (The Out of Club Skaters Club will be responsible for collecting their skater's registration fees and paying Host Club.)

DEADLINE FOR REGISTATION: APRIL 10, 2023, MIDNIGHT.

There is a CAP or Maximum Amount so register early to avoid disappointment.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of close of entries. There will be a \$10.00 administration fee applied to all withdrawal refunds. After the closing date of entries (APRIL 10) there will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.

MUSIC REGISTRATION:

St. Albert Club Skaters: Your music is already submitted and on the system for the competition. Please bring 2 CDs to board level for back-up.

Out of Club Skaters: Please submit your music before the registration deadline to <u>info@stalbertskatingcentre.com</u> in MP3 format and bring 2 CDs to board level for backup.

WHAT TO DO ON THE DAY: <u>Remember the day can run ahead or behind.</u> Skater Check In on site Opens: 1 hour before the first event and will be at the entrance to Troy Murray Arena.

- Check In at Registration <u>one hour before your event</u>. Come dressed in outfit and hair tied back when you arrive. You will receive instructions and goodies at the Registration table.
- Find your Coach and Assigned Dressing Room.
- Warm-up off-ice 30 minutes before your flight.
- Skates go on 15 minutes before your on-ice warm-up time.
- Go on the ice and compete.
- Go to the podium area with your skates on an await your result. Once your group is done the results will take approximately 15 minutes.

The Event is being held under the current rules of the Association Official Rulebook. The nature of the Event is defined in the Skate Canada Rule Book > Competitions. The Association reserves the right to alter the overall procedures to be followed during any part of the Event, if such alteration is in the best interest of the skaters or the Association.

CATEGORIES: The following categories are to be held:

- **PRE-STAR ELEMENTS:** Backwards skating (push glide sequences with foot lifted in front), Forwards crossovers on a circle, Waltz Jump, Forward Power Jump (Bunny-hop), 1-foot spin, Spiral on a line. (Jumps and spins may be from a standstill or moving)
- **STAR 1 ELEMENTS:** Waltz Jump, Salchow Jump, Toe Loop Jump, Forward Upright Spin, Backwards Upright Spin, Forward & Backwards crossovers on a circle, Forward Spiral Circles, Creative Expression
- **ADULT STAR 1 ELEMENTS:** Waltz Jump, Salchow Jump, Toe Loop Jump, Forward Upright Spin, Backwards Upright Spin, Forward & Backwards crossovers on a circle, Forward Spiral Circles, Feedback with Judge
- ADULT PROGRAM: NO RANKINGS-just report cards awarded.
- STAR 2 PROGRAM: Solo 2:10 Max, As prescribed by Skate Canada
- STAR 3 PROGRAM: Solo 2:00 +/- 0:10, As prescribed by Skate Canada
- STAR 4 PROGRAM: Solo 2:00 +/- 0:10, As prescribed by Skate Canada NO RANKINGS-just report cards awarded.

START ORDERS & REPORT CARDS: The start order will be posted on St. Albert Skating Clubs website. <u>www.stalbertskatingcentre.com</u> and on site. Skater report cards will be provided on-site at the end of each flight/event at the podium and ribbons and awards will be given out there.

Coaches: are allowed to be on-ice during element events with or without skates on. Coaches can only be at board level during the Star 2-4 events & Adult Program event.

Volunteers: will be contacted by volunteer Coordinator Carolyn Garritano to run this event, and older SASC skaters can take shifts. Skaters 14+ years, passed Star 5 Freeskate, who want to volunteer as a Judge at this event please contact Deborah Lyon at info@stalbertskatingcentre.com (there are 6 spots).

Volunteer Snack Room: will be provided in Dressing Room. This is also the meeting place for your volunteer sign in and instructions.

Volunteer Duties Include: Ice Captain, Registration, Hospitality, Music, Runners, Data Entry Official, Raffle & Flower Table, Podium/Presentation. New Volunteers will be paired with experienced Volunteers and as you work in pairs you will be able to see your skater. Deborah Lyon will be your on-site Volunteer Coordinator and Competition Chair.

Volunteer Shifts Length: are for the entire duration of the Fun Meet in most cases. (5:00-8:30pm)
